

AGM Bylaw Changes Summary – January 26, 2010

Page/Bylaw	Description of change
Bylaw 3.2 Page 5	Strike the following from Bylaw 3.2 “ <i>The Students’ Council has authority to modify the U-Pass fee by up to 5% in any given year to account for price fluctuations in the U-Pass program without amending the fee schedule.</i> ” The U-Pass program administration has been transferred from the Students’ Association to the University.
Bylaw 4.2.1 Page 6	Bylaw to state: “ <i>Students’ Council may convene special general meetings of the Students’ Association with 75% board approval</i> ” There was previously no threshold established for the board to call a special general meeting.
Bylaw 4.2.2 Page 6	Bylaw to state: “ <i>Special general meetings will be convened by the Students’ Council if a written request of 3% of the Active members of the Students’ Association is received and appropriate notice is given</i> ”. Reduced from 10%
Bylaw 5.3 (c) Page 8	Change of “ <i>Conservatory and Continuing Education</i> ” representative position to “ <i>Conservatory and Education</i> ”.
Bylaw 7.4.1 Page 14	Addition of “ <i>shall</i> ” between “ <i>committee</i> ” and “ <i>meet</i> ”
Bylaw 10.1 Page 21	Addition of “ <i>with the exception of the Commissioners</i> ” in the sentence “ <i>There shall be an annual election for all members of Students’ Council including</i>

	<i>the Executive Officers</i> ". Commissioners are appointed at the beginning of the Fall semester.
Bylaw 10.4.1 Page 21	Bylaw to state: " <i>10.4.1 If the President of the Students' Association vacates or resigns from office:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>in the spring, summer months and fall semester, a bi-election will be held to fill the position.</i> • <i>during the winter, a remaining Executive Officer (after nomination) shall be elected President by Students' Council</i>". Changed to have Students' Council elected President from Executive Committee instead of Executive Committee electing themselves.
Bylaw 11.4.8 Page 24	Strike Bylaw 11.4.8 completely " <i>If the respondent removed from office pursuant to 11.4.7 above has received an honorarium for services to be performed by him or her during the school year, s/he will immediately reimburse the Students' Association of Mount Royal University on a pro rata basis for the portion of the year that s/he is unable, through disqualification, to perform the functions for which the honorarium was intended.</i> " These occurrences should be treated on a case-by-case basis.
